About the role

Under limited direction and working in a Team environment, perform security clearance assessments in accordance with the Protective Security Policy Framework (PSPF), Client organisation instructions, relevant guidelines and standard operating procedures.

- Conduct interviews, develop assessments and make evidence-based recommendations about an individual's suitability to hold or maintain a high level clearance in accordance with risk management principles.
- Conduct checks and perform administrative functions for vetting assessments.
- Conduct research and review existing holdings.
- Engage with clearance applicants and external stakeholders to fill gaps in information.
- Gather and analyse security relevant information.
- Prepare high quality, evidence-based reports that analyse an individual's suitability to access national security classified material.
- Travel in order to conduct vetting assessments as required.



In this position you may be asked to conduct assessments across a range of security clearance levels (Baseline, NV1 and NV2).

About you

To be successful in this role, you will:

- Hold a strong loyalty to Australia, its people and our shared national security interests.
- Have a high level of integrity and ethics that align with Australia's national security interests.
- Have the ability to remove personal bias and make evidence-based assessments in line with policy, procedures and guidelines.
- Protect classified information including adhering to the need-to-know principle.
- Have experience in, or understanding of, the Australian Federal Government and PSPF.
- Have effective time management skills to enable management of an active caseload and meet deadlines.
- Work effectively within a team and autonomously.
- Have strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Be proficient with spelling and grammar.
- Have a high attention to detail and accuracy.
- Have strong computer literacy and ability to learn new information systems.
- Have the ability to touch-type at a speed of at least 50 WPM.

Eligibility requirements

- Australian Citizen.
- Hold a Certificate IV in Government Security (Personnel Vetting).
- Assessed as suitable to work in this position through the MPS Organisational Suitability Assessment Process.
- Hold or be eligible to hold a security clearance of Negative Vetting 1 (NV1).

Working remotely

You are required to have a suitable home office fully equipped with items you will need to safely and effectively perform the duties of this role including a desk, chair, computer monitors and a secure lockable cabinet.

For security reasons, your home office must be secure and not easily accessible by others in your home. You are not permitted to share your workspace with others.



Organisational Suitability Assessment

To work in MPS all prospective employees must undertake an Organisational Suitability Assessment (OSA). The OSA process evaluates how well a candidate is likely to fit within the MPS culture, values, structure and working environment.
